- Based on a survey of the 100S, some young people are invited directly by the career counselling service.

- Registration for counseling can be done by either party (the adolescent, the parents or the teacher).

How do I recognize the need for counselling?

If you as a parent are concerned with any of the questions below, counseling at the BSL may be worth exploring:

- Which occupations match my child's interests and strengths?
- Should my child choose basic vocational training or middle school?
- Is the school performance sufficient for the desired occupation or a secondary school?
- What plan B / career alternatives are there?
- What to do if the search for an apprenticeship has not been successful (yet)?
- What bridge services might be appropriate in my child's situation?
